Serangoon Gardens, Singapore

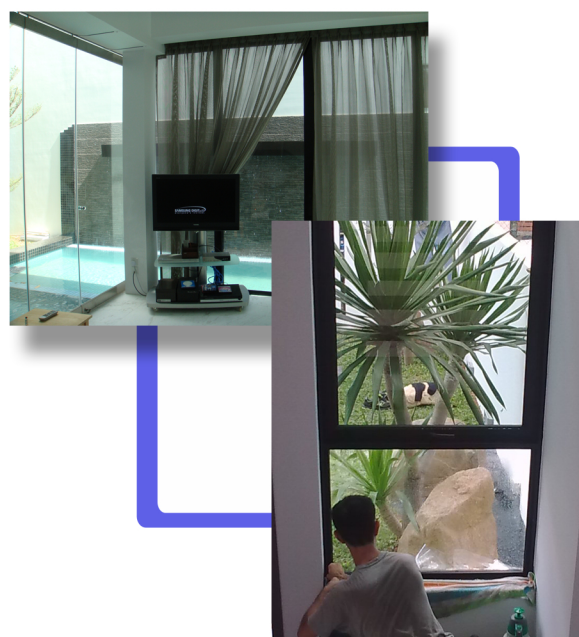


The owner of a detach house in Serangoon Gardens, Singapore has recently re-built her house. The design of her new home is a modern 3 storey building and it incorporates all the looks of a modern home, including high ceilings in the living hall, 4 bed rooms, side family hall, open-concept kitchen layout and view of the side pool area. However, much of the façade is covered using tall, full-length windows and this created much problem especially during the morning period when the sun shines directly into the house.

The owner contacted us and requested us to help her solve this problem. We viewed the whole layout of the house and presented her with our proposal. We proposed using a full sputtered film in medium light transmission. This will achieve the effect of maximum heat rejection and glare reduction while allowing sufficient natural light to pass through the windows. The neutral look of the films will minimize any alterations to the outlook of the new house as well.

We completed installing the whole house with Classis window films within a day, with minimum fuss and complications, so as to allow the owner to move into her new home on time. The effect of Classis window films was felt from the first moment the first piece of film was put up in the kitchen! The kitchen and dining area was terribly warm in the morning as the sun shone in. When the film was put up, the effect could be felt instantaneously and the owner was ecstatic.
